



2004 TeMPT

Tempranillo/ Merlot/ Petit Verdot

Varietal: 73% Tempranillo, 15% Merlot, 12% Petit Verdot.

Region: Rowland Flat, Barossa Valley.

Vineyard and Vinification:

Planted in 2000-01 on 1.5 acres of heavy red/black soils, the vines produced 3.5 tonnes per acre. It was the last fruit picked, in a relatively warm year at 14.0°Baume.

Traditional hand plunging of the skins, basket pressing and non-filtration, have achieved excellent colour and flavour extraction.

Oak maturation of 8 months in French and Hungarian oak.

Tasting Notes:

A wholly tempting wine blend.

Deep, dark red-purple with a blue tinge. A fruit-driven style with pronounced raspberry, mulberry and floral aromas. Ripe berries, subtle oak and mushroom flavours entwine with the soft fine tannins. An elegant and balanced wine.

Alcohol: 13.7% v/v.

Cellar: Now to 5 years.

Closure: Screw cap.



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
